

AFTER YOUR FACE-LIFT SURGERY

Post-Op Instructions

- Driver For outpatient procedures a driver will be required to take you home and preferably stay with you overnight. Please do not drive for 24 hours or while taking pain medication.
- Follow-up Please call to schedule your first follow-up appt, if not already scheduled.
- Medication Begin taking your antibiotic (cephalexin) the day after surgery. Please finish all of this medication.
- Bathing You may sit in the tub immediately. Do not get the dressings wet. You may shower once the dressings and drains have been removed.
- Sutures Removed at five days (in front of ear and chin), and approximately 10 days behind the ear.
- Drains You will be sent home with drains in place. Prior to leaving the OR you will be instructed how to keep track of your drainage output. Drains will be removed in one to three days.
- Activity Refrain from vigorous activity for ONE week after surgery. Excessive activity can cause bleeding, swelling and generally hamper the results.
- Swelling You may be swollen and bruised for the first several weeks after surgery. This will improve! Apply ICE to the surgical site for the first 48 hours after surgery.
- Garment A garment will be worn at all times (day & night) for the next THREE weeks or as much as possible.
- Call Feel free to call me or my nurses with questions or concerns.
